## WARNING

You as the owner are responsible for seeing that the installation and operation of your system complies with NFPA codes as well as any applicable state and local codes. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury.

## LIMITED WARRANTY

Standard Technologies, LLC provides a three year / 36,000 mile warranty, against defects in material and workmanship for fuel tanks. The warranty period shall begin on the date of purchase by original purchaser. At Standard Technologies discretion, parts will be replaced on an exchange basis FOB – Fremont. OH or buyer will be refunded the purchase price.

The warranty shall not apply if:

1. Damage is caused by misuse or negligence
2. Damage is caused by improper installation
3. Damage is caused during shipment
4. Damage is caused by contaminated fuels or fuel additives

This warranty does not cover consequential damages.

To make a claim against this warranty, please contact Standard Technologies at 419-332-6434. Standard Technologies will require part numbers, proof of purchase, and installation date. The company will notify customer to send the product, transportation prepaid, to its offices in Fremont, OH.

This warranty gives you specific rights and you may have other rights which vary from state to state. Warranty is in compliance with Magnuson Moss Consumer Warranty Act.

If your fuel system includes a refueling station option, see the enclosed GPI EZ-8RV fuel pump owner's manual for safety instructions, installation, operation, maintenance, troubleshooting, specifications, parts list and service. GPI Fuel pumps are covered by a two year limited warranty policy.

## FUEL SYSTEM INSTALLATION

**Fuel Tank Installation:** Fuel tanks must be installed according to NFPA codes. Tanks equipped with mounting brackets must be used with nuts, bolts and lock washers that are compliant with NFPA 5.10.3.5 and must be of Grade 8 type.

**Install Fuel and Vent Hoses** To install fuel and vent hoses make sure surfaces are clean. Select appropriate constant tension type or worm gear clamp and slide onto the end of hose. Carefully seat hose on the end of the fitting and slide hose past greater than 2/3 of barb. Position clamps 3/8" from the end of seated hose. Clamps should be tightened securely and not over tightened.

## CALIFORNIA LIMITED WARRANTY

### CALIFORNIA EMISSION CONTROL WARRANTY STATEMENT YOUR WARRANTY RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

The California Air Resources Board and Standard Technologies are pleased to explain the evaporative emission control system warranty on your 2016 Generator Set Equipment. In California, new Generator Set Equipment must be designed, built and equipped to meet the State's stringent anti-smog standards. Standard Technologies must warrant the EECS on your Generator Set Equipment for the period of time listed below provided there has been no abuse, neglect or improper maintenance of your Generator Set Equipment.

Your EECS may include parts such as the carburetor, fuel-injection system, the ignition system, catalytic converter, fuel tanks, fuel lines, fuel caps, valves, canisters, filters, vapor hoses, clamps, connectors, and other associated emission-related components.

Where a warrantable condition exists, Standard Technologies will repair your Generator Set Equipment at no cost to you including diagnosis, parts and labor.

#### **MANUFACTURER'S WARRANTY COVERAGE:**

This evaporative emission (or emissions) control system is warranted for two years. If any evaporative emission-related part on your equipment is defective, the part will be repaired or replaced by Standard Technologies.

#### **OWNER'S WARRANTY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

As the Generator Set Equipment owner, you are responsible for performance of the required maintenance listed in your owner's manual. Standard Technologies recommends that you retain all receipts covering maintenance on your Generator Set Equipment, but Standard Technologies cannot deny warranty solely for the lack of receipts.

As the Generator Set Equipment owner, you should however be aware that Standard Technologies may deny you warranty coverage if your Generator Set Equipment or a part has failed due to abuse, neglect, or improper maintenance or unapproved modifications.

You are responsible for presenting your Generator Set Equipment to Standard Technologies distribution center or service center as soon as the problem exists. The warranty repairs should be completed in a reasonable amount of time, not to exceed 30 days. If you have a question regarding your warranty coverage, you should contact Standard Technologies at 419-332-6434.

#### **GENERAL EMISSIONS WARRANTY COVERAGE:**

Standard Technologies warrants to the ultimate purchaser and each subsequent purchaser that the Generator Set Equipment is:

Designed, built and equipped so as to conform with all applicable regulations; and

Free from defects in materials and workmanship that cause the failure of a warranted part to be identical in all material respects to that part as described in Standard Technologies application for certification.

The warranty period begins on the date the Generator Set Equipment is delivered to an ultimate purchaser or first placed into service. The warranty period is two years.

Subject to certain conditions and exclusions as stated below, the warranty on emission-related parts is as follows:

(1) Any warranted part that is not scheduled for replacement as required maintenance in the written instructions supplied, is warranted for the warranty period stated above. If the part fails during the period of warranty coverage, the part will be repaired or replaced by Standard Technologies according to subsection (4) below. Any such part repaired or replaced under warranty will be warranted for the remainder of the period.

(2) Any warranted part that is scheduled only for regular inspection in the written instructions supplied is warranted for the warranty period stated above. Any such part repaired or replaced under warranty will be warranted for the remaining warranty period.

(3) Any warranted part that is scheduled for replacement as required maintenance in the written instructions supplied is warranted for the period of time before the first scheduled replacement date for that part. If the part fails before the first scheduled replacement, the part will be repaired or replaced by Standard Technologies according to subsection (4) below. Any such part repaired or replaced under warranty will be warranted for the remainder of the period prior to the first scheduled replacement point for the part.

(4) Repair or replacement of any warranted part under the warranty provisions herein must be performed at a warranty station at no charge to the owner.

(5) Notwithstanding the provisions herein, warranty services or repairs will be provided at all of our distribution centers that are franchised to service the subject engines or equipment.

(6) The Generator Set Equipment owner will not be charged for diagnostic labor that is directly associated with diagnosis of a defective, emission-related warranted part, provided that such diagnostic work is performed at a warranty station.

(7) Standard Technologies is not liable for damages to other engine or equipment components proximately caused by a failure under warranty of any warranted part.

(8) Throughout the Generator Set Equipment warranty period stated above, Standard Technologies will maintain a supply of warranted parts sufficient to meet the expected demand for such parts.

(9) Any replacement part may be used in the performance of any warranty maintenance or repairs and must be provided without charge to the owner. Such use will not reduce the warranty obligations of Standard Technologies.

(10) Add-on or modified parts that are not exempted by the Air Resources Board may not be used. The use of any non-exempted add-on or modified parts by the ultimate purchaser will be grounds for disallowing a warranty claims. Standard Technologies will not be liable to warrant failures of warranted parts caused by the use of a non-exempted add-on or modified part.

#### **WARRANTED PARTS:**

The repair or replacement of any warranted part otherwise eligible for warranty coverage may be excluded from such warranty coverage if Standard Technologies demonstrates that the Generator Set Equipment has been abused, neglected, or improperly maintained, and that such abuse, neglect, or improper maintenance was the direct cause of the need for repair or replacement of the part. That notwithstanding, any adjustment of a component that has a factory installed, and properly operating, adjustment limiting device is still eligible for warranty coverage. The following emission warranty parts list are covered:

- (2) Fuel Cap
- (3) Fuel Fill Neck
- (3) Fuel Line
- (4) Fuel Line Fittings
- (5) Clamps
- (6) Pressure Relief Valves
